



Sippihaw Swim Club Pool Rules - 2019

FACILITY RULES

1. Members and their guests must observe all rules of the Sippihaw Swim Club, the health department, and the town/state.
2. All members and their guests must check in at the entrance of the club before entering. Members with balances due or who are not in good standing will not be allowed to enter the pool.
3. Smoking/tobacco/nicotine products, including e-cigarettes, are strictly prohibited everywhere on the property.
4. Animals, scooters, rollerblades, and skateboards are not allowed on the property. Bicycles must be parked on the sides, not at the front door.
5. Beverages are only allowed on the pool deck in cans, paper, or plastic containers. NO GLASS containers or any item containing glass, including swim goggles or face masks (tempered glass is NOT PERMITTED) are allowed on the property. Any person or person(s) that introduce broken glass into the pool area will be financially responsible for all damages, including but not limited to: injuries, cleaning, refilling pool and chemicals, loss of revenue and wages, and will occur a minimum charge of \$5000.00. Alcoholic beverages must be kept discreet with a koozie. Kegs or any other cooler type containers containing alcoholic beverages are prohibited. State and local laws regarding the consumption of alcohol must be observed. The lifeguards have the authority to ask any person/s that appear to be impaired or are being disruptive to leave the property. All infractions will be reported to the management for possible further action.
6. No grills or flammable products allowed on club property.
7. All members are required to clean up after themselves and their guests. All members must place their trash in proper trash/recycling containers.
8. Any injuries sustained anywhere on club property must immediately be reported to the lifeguard on duty for first aid supplies. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. The club assumes no responsibility for injuries or damage resulting from use.
9. Trespassing and/or vandalism of pool properties by any member or their guests will result in a minimum of an automatic suspension of pool privileges for the violator/s without refund. Violators will be prosecuted and will be held responsible for all damages.
10. Management and lifeguard rules and requests for safety will be applied, even when they seem to contradict these rules. Rules and policies may be amended at any time with or without notice to members. A copy will be available by request.

POOL RULES

1. Lifeguards may not be on duty. Lifeguards are only on duty at the large pool. No one is allowed to use the pool unless lifeguard is on duty.
2. Members and guests assume all risks and responsibility. Members and their guests must follow all instructions given by the lifeguards. Failure to comply with instructions given by the lifeguards is grounds for immediate removal from the pool.
3. All persons entering the pool must wear proper bathing attire. No street clothes or diapers (except as noted) are permitted.
4. Children in diapers and those not completely potty trained are required to wear both disposable swim diapers and a vinyl/rubber diaper cover. Members must pay the entire cost of returning the pool to operational status as a result of any action which causes the pool to be closed. Any deviation from this policy by any member or guest shall cause the member to be charged and may lose club membership without refund.
5. Children under the age of 14 are not permitted to enter facility unless accompanied and directly supervised by an adult.
6. No running or rough play is allowed. Parents/guardians are responsible for the behavior of their children, whether or not the parent is present.
7. Floats, balls, water guns, etc. are allowed only at the discretion of the lifeguards. Water guns may not exceed one foot in length. Balls or other toys must be constructed of a soft material designed and intended for pool use.
8. The lifeguards will stop any activity that is considered unsafe or interferes with the quiet enjoyment of the pool.
9. All children requiring a flotation device and non-swimmer children must remain within arm's length of a responsible adult.
10. Children must pass a swimming test prior to being allowed in the deep end.
11. The children's wading pool may only be used by non-swimmers under the age of 5.
12. Swimmers are not allowed to spit or spout water back in the pool.
13. Food and beverages are prohibited within 10 feet of the edge of the large pool or within the fenced wading pool area.
14. The pools will be closed during any emergency situation, such as in the event of strong storms or in the event that lightning is observed.
Lifeguards will decide when the pool area is safe to be used and are the final authority.

GUEST POLICIES

1. The guest fee of \$5 per person is due prior to entering the facility.
2. All guests must be signed in at the front desk with the sponsor member's name.
3. Guests may attend a maximum of 4 times per year and may not reside in the member's household.
4. A maximum of 4 guests per household are allowed per day.
5. Guests are not replacements for family members that are not in attendance.
6. The facilities are available to guests of members only when accompanied by a member. Members must remain with their guests at all times.
7. Prior approval is required to add a nanny/babysitter to your family membership at an additional fee.
8. Guests must be within the control of and are the full responsibility of the member accompanying them. All guests are required to abide by all the rules set forth by the Sippihaw Swim Club.

HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT

I agree that staff may administer first aid, perform CPR, and authorize a physician of their choice to provide emergency care on my behalf. I understand that all medical costs incurred are my responsibility. I (on behalf of myself, my children, guests, and other members) hereby assume all liability for risks and hazards incidental to the use of Sippihaw Swim Club facility. I release and forever discharge and absolve and indemnify

-Special Donor Member Regulations and Guidelines-

A limited number of Sippihaw Swim Club Special Donor Member privilege packages are available from August 27, 2018 through June 12th, 2019. As a Sippihaw Swim Club Special Donor Member (referred to as "Donor" in this document), you are entitled to certain privileges as listed below and may enjoy these privileges only while in good Member standing while following all of the rules and guidelines.

BECOMING A SPECIAL DONOR

Prospective Special Donors must submit an application, and if approved, must submit the required donation at our online store in order to be considered a Special Donor. Permitted vehicles will be identified by their corresponding license plate. Donors may also receive a special decal or other unique identifying item that identifies them and their vehicle as a Special Donor that will be required to display at all times. Donations are non-refundable and does not guarantee Donor uninterrupted access and use of the facilities. Donor Memberships and all privileges may be revoked for violating any of the rules listed here and/or engaging in any illegal activity while at the Sippihaw Swim Club and included property located at 312 Powhatan Drive, Fuquay-Varina, NC 27526, (referred to as "property" in this document).

PARKING

Parking is available only to Donors who have been approved and designated as such by the Sippihaw Swim Club. Parking shall be "RESERVED" by assigned and numbered spaces only. Parking passes and/or privileges are not transferrable and may not be re-sold, traded or otherwise re-assigned either temporarily or permanently by anyone with exception of transactions specifically approved by the Sippihaw Swim Club. Vehicles on the property that are not displaying the required identification shall be towed and stored at vehicle owner's expense.

If a Donor's assigned space is occupied by an unauthorized vehicle, the Donor may park in the handicap space and send a picture of the unauthorized vehicle to fuquaypool@hotmail.com so that it can be towed and stored at violator's expense. (Include license plate and space # in pic).

Parking is allowed in marked and paved spaces only. ANY VEHICLE PARKED ON THE STREET PERIMETER, TENNIS COURTS AND NON-DESIGNATED PARKING SPACES WILL BE TOWED & STORED AT VEHICLE OWNER'S EXPENSE.

FACILITY ACCESS

Vehicular and pedestrian access to the designated parking area is allowed during the permitted times of use only. No other areas or structures are permitted for access, including but not limited to: inside of the fenced-in pool area, out buildings, clubhouse, wooded areas behind the pool and tennis court and adjacent properties.

AVAILABILITY OF FACILITIES:

All privileges and facility accesses granted herein shall be available for the following days and times ONLY:

The **DAYS** available shall reflect all of the 2018-19 Wake County Traditional Calendar regularly scheduled school days and make-up days in which Fuquay-Varina High School students are required to attend school beginning August 27, 2018 and ending June 11, 2019. The calendar can be viewed here:

The **HOURS** of availability for facility access shall begin no earlier than **6:20 AM** or 1 hour prior to when Fuquay-Varina High School classes are scheduled to begin for that day, or whichever is later. Facility access shall end promptly at **2:45 PM** on each of those days, or 30 minutes following any early school release, whichever is earlier. Vehicles arriving earlier or remaining later than these stated times are subject to removal by towing and storage at owner's expense. No overnight parking is permitted.

All parking and facility use may be temporarily suspended and unavailable due to: FLOODING, ICE, SNOW, OR ANY IMPENDING CONDITION DEEMED UNSAFE OR UNLAWFUL FOR ACCESS OR PARKING. Sippihaw Swim Club will not be responsible for plowing or removing any naturally occurring ground coverage that will remedy itself naturally. No refunds or credits shall be given for any loss of use claims.

GENERAL RULES

1. ALL MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN ACTIONS AS WELL AS THE ACTIONS OF THEIR GUESTS AND PASSENGERS. PASSENGER, GUEST, OR MEMBER MISCONDUCT MAY RESULT IN REVOKED PRIVILEGES AND/OR BEING TRESPASSED.
2. ALL SMOKING, ILLICIT DRUGS, ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS, INCLUDING E-CIGARETTES AND ALL FORMS OF VAPE, ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED FROM USE OR POSSESSION THEREOF ON THE PROPERTY.
3. NO WEAPONS ARE ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY.
4. NO FIGHTING, LOITERING, OR OTHERWISE OBJECTIVE OR ILLEGAL BEHAVIOR IS PERMITTED.
5. Drones, scooters, rollerblades, skateboards, or any wheeled toy, excluding bicycles & member's registered vehicles, are not allowed.
6. No loud vehicles or activities are allowed. This includes loud music, exhaust, engines, horns, or any other device, activity, or display, deemed a nuisance.
7. No careless and/or wreckless driving or travelling in the parking lot in excess of 5 MPH.
8. Food and/or beverages are not allowed to be consumed on the property.
9. All Members and their guests must not leave any trash on property or on other adjacent properties.
10. All persons using the facility do so at their own risk.
11. Sippihaw Swim Club assumes no responsibility for injuries or damages resulting from use.
12. Trespassing and/or vandalism to the facility by any member or their guests will result in a minimum of an automatic suspension without refund. Violators will be prosecuted and compensation for damages will be collected.
13. Parking lot and grounds may be under 24 hr video and audio surveillance and may be made available to 3rd parties.
14. Rules and policies may be amended at any time. A revised copy will be available by request.
